

ABSTRACT

The year 2024 is a crucial period for the Indonesian House of Representatives because at that time there will be discussions on strategic issues that have a broad impact on society and government. In that year, there will be a transition period from Legislative Members for the 2019-2024 Period to Legislative Members for the 2024-2029 Period, so that an adjustment process is needed, including in the Plenary Meeting of the Indonesian House of Representatives. The Plenary Meeting of the Indonesian House of Representatives is the highest decision-making forum in the Indonesian legislative institution. One important aspect in supporting the Plenary Meeting is communicating information visually, either through infographic displays or through the arrangement of the seating layout of the Indonesian House of Representatives members. This study aims to design infographic displays and seating layouts at the Plenary Meeting of the Indonesian House of Representatives Members for the 2024-2029 Period in order to increase the effectiveness of communication through professional and impartial infographic displays and seating layouts for the Indonesian House of Representatives Members for the 2024-2029 Period based on non-verbal communication theory. Data collection methods used include observation, interviews, and documentation. The results show that infographic displays that pay attention to the principles of nonverbal communication produce informative, professional, and neutral infographics. Meanwhile, the seating layout that is arranged by considering the aspects of nonverbal communication can produce a layout that can be accepted by all factions, thereby increasing the effectiveness of communication.
