Pendekatan visual yang terinspirasi dari karya seniman film pendek seperti Wregas Bhanuteja, Naomi Kawase, dan Martin McDonagh digunakan untuk membangun narasi simboli yang reflektif. Film ini tidak sekadar merekam ulang ritual, tetapi menghadirkan tafsir sinematik yang menggugah kesadaran akan pentingnya melanjutkan warisan budaya. Melalui perpaduan teknik visual kontemporer dan kekayaan makna lokal, karya ini diharapkan menjadi bentuk kesadaran sekaligus upaya pelestarian budaya dalam lanskap digital yang terus berkembang.

*The Tembuni tradition is one of the cultural rituals of Sundanese society that is full of spiritual meaning and symbolism, especially in the context of birth and respect for the baby's placenta. In the dynamics of modernization and globalization, this tradition has begun to lose relevance in the eyes of the younger generation who are more rational and scientific. This final project seeks to re-explore the spiritual values in the Tembuni Tradition through the medium of a short film, which is expected to bridge the gap in understanding between the older and younger generations. A visual approach inspired by the work of short film artists such as Wregas Bhanuteja, Naomi Kawase, and Martin McDonagh is used to build a reflective, symbiotic narrative. The film does not simply re-record the ritual, but presents a cinematic interpretation that raises awareness of the importance of continuing cultural heritage. Through a combination of contemporary visual techniques and rich local meanings, this work is expected to be a form of awareness as well as an effort to preserve culture in an ever-evolving digital landscape.*
