In this design and research process, the primary methodology employed by the author is qualitative research through a literature review and observation. In order to gather data for this study, the author conducted a review and analysis of relevant articles and journals on the topic of character design for an animated work that conveys messages related to the deforestation of forests in Lombok. The findings of this study comprise a conceptual design for character creation, including character turnaround, expressions, and gestures, which serve as a guide for the visual concept applied to the production of the animated film Tiok Ampok.
