ABSTRACT

The Department of Archives and Library of Banjarnegara Regency serves as an educational facility in the form of a public library. It is housed in a new building that presents several challenges, particularly in terms of interior design and insufficient facilities. These include a reading area with non-ergonomic furniture, overcrowded furniture placement, and a lack of accessible features for people with disabilities. This study aims to redesign the library's interior using a Human-Centric approach that prioritizes space flexibility to support diverse activities, along with improved accessibility that enhances user comfort and experience, creating a more inviting atmosphere. Through observation, analysis, literature review, comparative studies, and precedent studies, the proposed redesign is expected to improve comfort and offer a new attraction for the people of Banjarnegara Regency.
