

ABSTRACT

Karanganyar Regency is a regency in Central Java Province with a relatively large population. One of the districts within Karanganyar Regency is Colomadu District. Colomadu District is located far from the administrative area of Karanganyar Regency, resulting in uneven distribution of facilities in the area, one of which is the lack of health facilities. According to the Karanganyar Regency Health Office, health in the area remains a concern, as seen from infant mortality rates, stunting cases, and limited access to health facilities. In terms of facilities, specialized clinics for mothers and children are still rare in Colomadu District, and the ratio between population and health facilities is still far from sufficient. Therefore, health facilities such as the Main Maternal and Child Clinic in Colomadu District are needed to meet the community's needs in terms of services, facilities, and environment. This design aims to provide quality, accessible health services and provide education for communities lacking in understanding of infant and maternal health. The design method used was a literature review, precedent study, comparative study, and analysis of primary and secondary data. The results of this design are expected to provide healthcare facilities that meet the needs of the Colomadu District community.
